TRANSFER STUDENTS

Transfer applicants are degree-seeking students who, at the time of application, have attempted college-level courseworkafter graduating high school or completing a GED program.

Applicants Must Submit:

1. An online Colorado State University Pueblo application

2. A \$25 application fee (non-refundable)

3. Official transcripts from **all** previous institutions of higher learning attended (see Transcript Requirements below).

4. An official final high school transcript if the applicant has earned **fewer than 30 credit hours** of college-level coursework (see Transcript Requirements below).

Combined 2.3 GPA

Transfer students must have a minimum 2.3 combined GPA (grade point average) on a 4.0 U.S. GPA scale for all completed college-level coursework. Students with less than a 2.3 GPA may be admissible if the student provides a statement regarding academic performance.

Transfer Credits

Transfer credits are evaluated by the Office of the Registrar after admission.

Transcript Requirements

All transfer students are required to provide official transcripts* from every institution of higher learning attended. This requirement includes transcripts from unaccredited colleges or universities, transcripts for non-transferable coursework and transcripts with incomplete or withdrawn grades. The Office of Admissions requires transcripts from any undisclosed institutions that appear on any transcripts provided. Transfer students with in-progress grades must provide official final transcripts after course completion. Transcripts are only considered official if issued directly to Colorado State University Pueblo by an institution of higher learning or the custodian of the records for a closed institution.

Transfer Students with Less Than 30 Credit Hours of College-Level Coursework

All transfer students with fewer than 30 credit hours of college-level coursework are required to provide a final official transcript* showing high school completion. Transcripts are only considered official if issued directly to Colorado State University Office Pueblo Office of Admissions by the high school, school district or state department of education.

*For students with non-U.S. transcripts: All international documentation must be translated, certified, and authenticated through an approved credentialing agency.
