

TEACHER EDUCATION PROGRAM

In collaboration with the Teacher Education Department, Extended Studies offers graduate-level coursework for degree- and non-degree-seeking educators interested in professional development, recertification, and/or graduate degrees. This program associates with education partners external to the university who offer graduate credit in curriculum and instruction, as well as a variety of disciplines. The credits are transcribed as ED 500 or ED 501. ED 500 is titled "Workshop" and is transcribed S/U for those courses that are designed as professional development and recertification. ED 501 is titled "Graduate Topics in Education" and is transcribed using A-F letter grades. ED 501 courses are eligible to count towards graduate credit/degrees, professional development, and/or recertification. All curricula and faculty are supervised by the Teacher Education Department.
